Dear Parents/Guardians of Eighth Grade Students:

The Graduation Dance is scheduled for Saturday, June 18 from 6:30-9:00 p.m. While this is not a formal event, students are expected to dress appropriately. Boys should wear dress pants, a dress shirt, and dress shoes. Ties are encouraged, but not required. Girls should wear a nice dress, or a skirt, or dress pants and a nice top. Admission is free. Guest passes can be obtained from Mr. Kelleher or Mrs. Sweet beginning in June. Guests must be 7th or 8th grade students.

Graduation is scheduled for Thursday, June 23 in the Middle School auditorium at 7:00 p.m. Each student will be given four tickets for graduation. Due to limited space in the auditorium there will be no extra tickets. Please consider returning tickets you do not plan to use, or you may also give them to someone who would like an extra ticket. Caps and gowns will also be distributed the week of graduation.

All students have been measured for caps & gowns to be worn at graduation. If you have not already done so, please send payment in the amount of \$17.75.

Some other information about graduation:

- students are strongly encouraged to wear dress clothes under their gowns
- graduates need to be at the school at 6:00 p.m.
- the graduation class picture will be taken in the gymnasium at 6:30 p.m.
- reserved seating is only for those participating in the ceremony and members of town boards
- there will be a reception for graduates and their families at the conclusion of the ceremony
